Who is Aliice? What does she represent to you and why did you create this public persona?

Aliice: I renamed myself Aliice as it is my story in a nutshell; my father dedicated his life to voicing beloved cartoon characters such as Scrappy Doo, so playing with my voice since I could speak has always come natural to me. Later in life I started a rock band called The Flick Leslies, which I was with for six years before naming myself Aliice; therefore, my love for rock music, my favorite band being Alice in Chains and my love for cartoons, my favorite movie being *Alice in Wonderland*, lead me to create the name Aliice, keeping an I from each world. The visual side to Aliice came from my respect for drag, learning how we can create a new persona to protect ourselves and become whoever the hell we want to be. Creating something colorful and beautiful, possibly from a place of pain or self-doubt.

You have been an ally for the LGBTQ+ community. Tell us more about this and what you're working on now regarding this community.

A: I have always been able to relate to the LGBTQ+ community,

since I was heavily bullied in Chile for not speaking the language and for simply being 'different'. Also, I have had many dear friends who are a part of the community. My love for them and my disapproval for anyone who stands in the way of others sharing the same rights has led me to wear the rainbow flag on multiple occasions. I sang at World Pride Madrid in 2017, Pride Chile in 2018 and since then I have been active in the community building Zoom chats where everyone can open up about their struggles and feel safe, connect and make new friends. I was lucky enough to have my music be the soundtrack to a young transgendered boy's journey on Telemundo's *100 días para enamorarnos*, and I feel blessed that so many young members of the community felt my music gave them strength to be themselves. They approached me on social media where we have built a safe space community of our own.

What's next for Aliice?

A: I can't sit still (literally, ever!), so I always have a ton of projects in the works. I am a very visual artist, so my plans usually go hand in hand with new crazy colorful looks, music videos, and digital covers that portray what the song is about. But these days I am

really focused on writing music for a few TV shows and combining my voice actor passion with my musical side, so I am auditioning for roles of cartoons with musical numbers, following my father's footsteps and hopefully putting a smile on everyone's face.

As an artist, what does 'success' mean to you?

A: Success to me is learning how to get up, try again, reinventing yourself and proving to be resilient. It's only a failure if you quit, but if we are taught it is simply part of the bumpy road to happiness and we can enjoy the safari, well, that sounds like success to me. || **A**
