LEATHERS is the solo project of Vancouver musician and tattoo artist Shannon Hemmett. I am also the synth player and backing vocalist for the Canadian post punk band, ACTORS.

When did the band get started and what was the original intention of the band?

SH: When I released the first single "Missing Scene" in 2016, the project had a 90s shoegaze influence, but as I wrote and released some different material, I've pursued a modern synthpop sound with a sleek visual aesthetic.

The musical and lyrical content of ACTORS has a dystopian, postpunk atmosphere whereas LEATHERS exists in a dreamier, darkromantic realm. I've always loved to sing, and LEATHERS provided an opportunity to showcase my voice and explore my interest in writing synth-based music. The lyrics tap into ideas of surrealism

and illusion, there's a mirage-like state between wakefulness and dreaming where the conscious and subconscious overlap, and I enjoy writing from that place.

How would you describe your music to someone who has not yet checked you out?

SH: Stylish goth melodies meet 80s pop sweetness.

What inspires you to create this style of music?

SH: There's a fascination with contrasts; lightness/darkness, feminine/masculine, fantasy/reality, creation/destruction. I love pop music from the 80s that has a darker sensibility.

What influences in fashion, literature and culture impact your

SH: Joan Didion, Patrick Nagel, Helmut Newton. Joan Didion's writing has a swift elegance, she can say so much in a single sentence. Her writings about the sinister side of glamour in Hollywood are particularly good, and were a huge inspiration to Bret Easton Ellis (who's another favorite author of mine). Patrick Nagel's iconic illustrations of women in the 80s inspires my own style, visually in my artwork/tattooing and aesthetically in the clothes I like to wear. Helmut Newton's photographs show women
